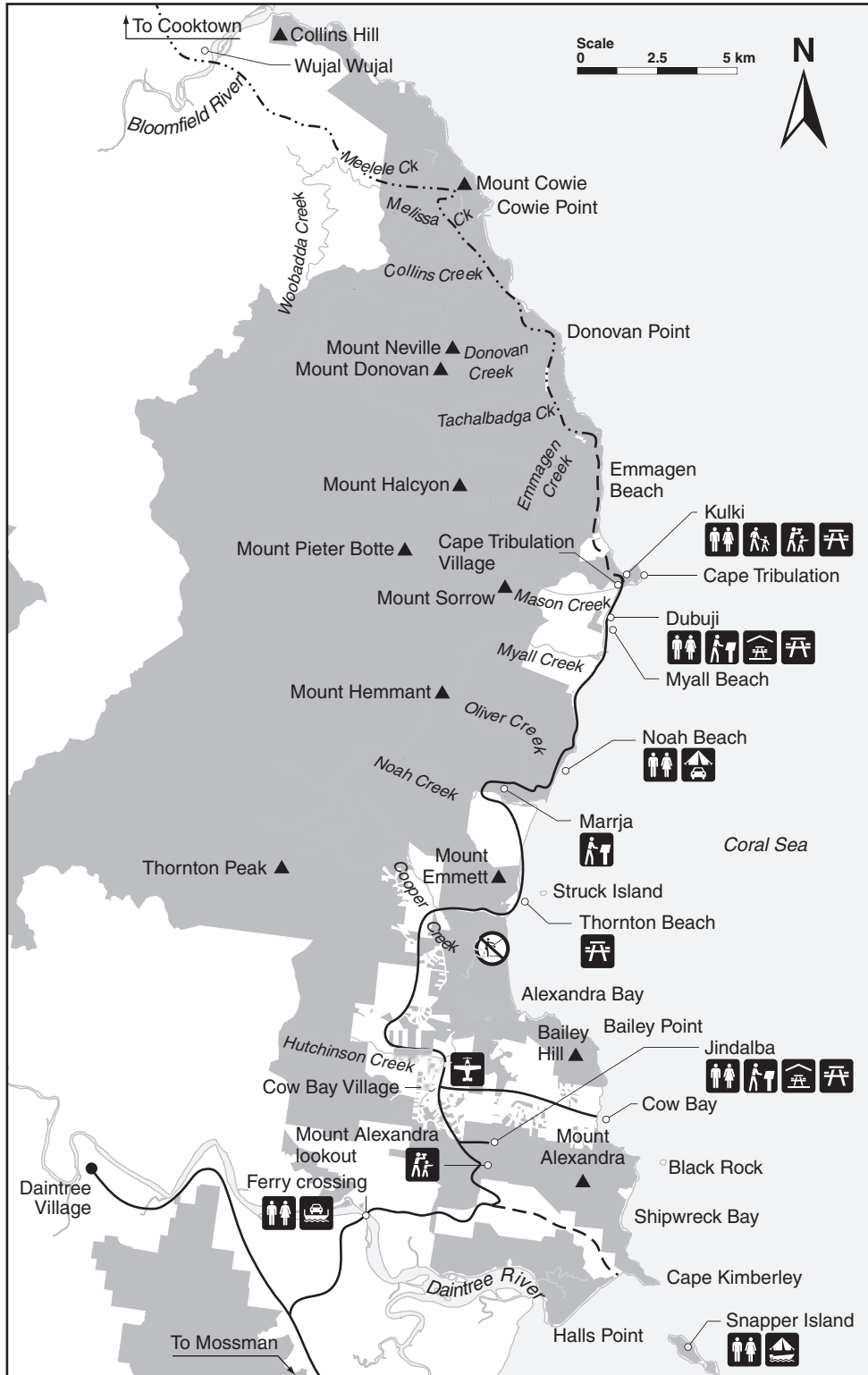


Daintree National Park map

The estuaries, beaches, reefs and coastal waters are protected as part of the Great Barrier Reef and Great Barrier Reef Coast marine parks. Marine Park zoning and other regulations apply within the marine parks.

Please ensure you have current zoning information. This map is not to be used for navigation purposes.



Warning: Estuarine crocodiles inhabit the sea, rivers and estuaries. They can also turn up on beaches. Attacks may cause injury or death. Do not swim in estuaries or rivers in the park.



Dangerous stinging jellyfish ('stingers') may be present in tidal and coastal waters at any time, but occur more frequently in the warmer months. A full body lycra suit or equivalent may provide protection against stinging jellyfish and sunburn.
